## **MEDITATION**

#### **Construction Pictures**

Much of the steel stud framing in the school is complete. The insides of all of the classrooms are being framed out and sheetrocked to conceal pipes and electrical conduit, provide space for insulation and to provide a better appearance than the old concrete block walls. Soffits are being constructed to conceal heating pipes and ducts, plumbing pipes, sprinkler pipes and conduit when they are near the ceiling. A new hallway will connect the main First Floor Hallway with the Lower Commons to provide wheelchair access from the south entrance to the bottom of the ramp, without going through the Music Room. A new post with a new footing and several steel beams are being installed to support the floor above, to create the opening required in the wall.
