
## **Construction Pictures**



The interiors of the Second Level classrooms in the 1961 are nearing completion. The vinyl composition floor tile has been installed, walls painted, ceilings and the new lighting installed. Installation of the new cabinets is moving well along. Interior finishes in the First Level of the 1961 Addition are following about a week behind those in the Second Level.



The concrete foundations were backfilled this week. The South Entrance door and window frame is being removed so that the new vestibule addition can be built.



Our water was shut off this past Tuesday so that the new fire sprinkler riser could be added to our existing water service in the Yard Storage Room (far SE corner of the school). The fire sprinklers in the school will be served by this fire riser while the fire sprinklers in the church and surrounding spaces will be served from our existing fire service in the room next to the church Boiler Room.



Installation of the cabinets in the 5 classrooms in the 2000 Addition getting new cabinets is nearly complete, except for the countertops.

#### Choir at St. John's
