Luke 16:1-15

Parables are earthly stories with a heavenly meaning. Some of the most remembered parables that Jesus spoke might include: The Parable of the Sower, The Parable of the Prodigal Son, and the Parable of the Lost Sheep, just to name a few. These parables seem to make sense as we see ourselves in the light of what Jesus was saying to those who were truly listening.

When we come to The Parable of the Shrewd Manager it takes many of us by surprise because the pieces just don't seem to fit. It's difficult for us to understand why The Lord of the Harvest would commend a manager who lied, cheated, schemed, and stole what didn't belong to him in order to make his life easier after being fired from the job. We find the answer to our questions in light of the mercy of the Master.

Mercy is getting what we don't deserve. To the manager...mercy. To those whose debts are paid...mercy. To those of us whose debts could never be repaid this side of heaven...mercy. The Master commended the shrewd manager because he used what was available to him to prepare for the days ahead. Construction Update



The old (possibly original) electrical panel in the Vestry has been removed and is being replaced. All panels, wiring, and devices in the renovated areas are being updated with new ones.



Brick has been installed on the South Entrance Vestibule projection. Until new doors are installed and the interior is finished, use these doors for emergency egress only.



The classroom unit ventilators have arrived, and the first is being installed. These units provide heating, cooling, and ventilation to the six classrooms in the 1961 Addition, with energy recovery wheels to temper incoming fresh air using exhaust air.



The original plaster and later tile ceilings in the Vestry and Sacristy have been removed to allow for insulation. New gypsum board ceilings will match the original vaulted design.
