# Deuteronomy 30:11-20

Moses had many defining moments in his life, some of which include: being placed in a basket and floating along the banks of the Nile River, tending sheep on the top of Mount Horeb and seeing a burning bush, and parting the waters of the Red Sea. Another defining moment occurs near the end of Moses' ministry as he stands on a mountain overlooking the Promised Land. It is here that he delivered some parting words to those who he led out of the bondage of slavery. His words are clear, direct, and to the point when he says, "the choice is yours, either you live in the new land that God is giving you or die in sin and the evil idols you choose to cling to."

# **Construction Update**

#### **Building Security During Construction**

Since the beginning of the project, all workers on the site must submit to background checks, which we review. In addition, all workers must wear name badges bearing their name and Langer Construction's logo. Since the beginning of school, exterior doors are closed and locked, with a limited number of door fobs given to crew foremen.



The opening in the basement wall where the coal bin was previously has been infilled with concrete, waterproofed and insulated. There is a drainage tile along the footing which will be connected to a new sump and pump. The gray pipes are electrical conduits for new electrical service to the exterior HVAC units and for the new electrical panels in the Boiler Room. The concrete column is for one of the posts for the screen wall around those HVAC units.



The small projection for the new south vestibule has been framed and sheathed; ready for brick. Due to limited space, about one third of the vestibule will be in this projection while the remaining two thirds will be inside the building. The vestibule will have wider doors which will allow access for individuals in wheelchairs.



Iron workers are installing the structure for the new stairway up to the Balcony. The structure for the stair is steel, but all exposed portions of it will be white oak, in the style to match the original stair. The new stair will have safe treads instead of having dangerous winder treads, which the original stair had.
