

MEDITATION

Malachi 3:13-18

We've all heard the common phrase, "Looks can be deceiving". What you see is not always what you get. A person, place, or object may be very different from how they initially appear at first glance. The saying emphasizes the importance of looking beyond superficial appearances to understand the true nature or quality of something or someone.

This Sunday is the Last Sunday of the Church Year before we enter the Season of Advent. It sounds so final yet looks can be deceiving. The readings give us glimpses of what at first glance looks unfair, but it turns out that our God is a Just God and His Will is always being done no matter how it may first appear.

The Prophet Malachi calls us the Lord's "treasured possession". We matter to Him, and Christ has paid the price for those who believe. St. Paul proclaims, "He has delivered us from the domain of darkness and transferred us to the kingdom of His beloved Son." The Gospel of Luke reminds us of the price paid for our sinfulness as Jesus hangs on the cross. His crucifixion looks as horrible as it was, but we have life eternal because He willingly died so that we might have Life in His name. While looks may be deceiving, there is "nothing that can separate us from the love of Christ Jesus our Lord." (Romans 8:39)

PRAYER

Lord You are the Giver of all good things. We give thanks to You for our lives and all You provide. Forgive us for the times we see the things of this world with deserving eyes instead of being grateful to You. While we might experience troubles and injustices in our lives, help us to remember that You are in control. You alone know what is best for us. Strengthen our faith to believe when we pray, "Thy Will be done on earth as it is in heaven." Amen.



Gypsum wallboard is being installed in the Fellowship Hall and surrounding spaces. The hallway in this photo leads to the new Men's and Women's Restrooms. A long-needed drinking fountain will be installed in the alcove to the left.



The two exterior HVAC units have been placed on their bases. The ductwork still needs to be installed and other connections made.



Sprinkler piping for the two side aisles needs to be installed below the wood ceilings. Wood soffits that will match the ceiling boards will be built to enclose the pipes.
