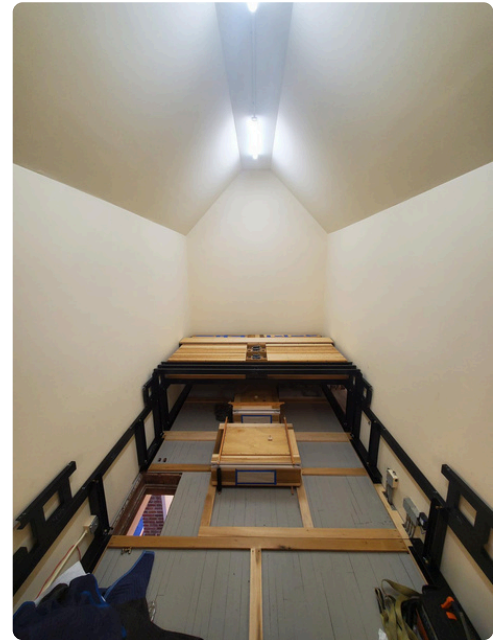

The wood flooring in the Sanctuary is receiving its final finish, and carpet installation will be coming soon. One more step closer to worshipping in our Sanctuary!
